

Pastor's Corner

Twenty-ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time October 20, 2024

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

My classmate, Father Burish who was visiting from La Crosse, Wisconsin returned home last Sunday evening and commented that we have so many friendly parishioners at our parish. He was also surprised by the number of Wisconsin connections people have with family and friends. It just goes to show the world is not as large as we sometimes think.

This Sunday, we celebrate the rite of welcome for those men and women who are preparing to receive the Sacrament of Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation in the coming months. At the 10:30 AM Mass, we have our 8th Graders in the Confirmation program who are in their final months of preparation and at the 6:30 PM Mass, the adults in the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (formerly called RCIA) program. Of the adults, we have Candidates seeking to receive the Eucharistic and Confirmation, and also Catechumens who are seeking to receive Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation. This is a reminder to all of us to pray for those making preparations for the sacraments and also to ask God to renew within us our own Baptism.

Next Sunday is my installation as Pastor of Saint Stephen's at the 10:30 AM Mass. Archbishop Cordileone is going to come to celebrate the Mass for all of us. Everyone is invited to attend the Mass and there will be a light reception in Donworth Hall afterwards. As I formerly begin my ministry as pastor, I request your prayers and the guidance of the Holy Spirit that I may be a faithful shepherd to our parish community.

OUR SAINT FOR THE WEEK: Saint Paul of the Cross

Feast Day October 20

Paul Francis Danei was born in Italy in 1694, the second of 16 children. Because of his father's financial difficulties, Paul had to leave school to help support his family. At age 15, he began to realize how much Jesus suffered for him. In response, he prayed and did difficult things such as sleeping on the floor and not eating foods he liked. He wanted to follow Christ more closely and share in his passion and death.



At age 20, Paul joined the Venetian army that was defending the faith. After a year, he went back to a life of prayer and penance. Then God called him to form a group of men dedicated to preaching parish missions. These men, called Passionists, would preach the mystery of Christ crucified—the mystery of the Father's love—in hopes that Christians would turn from their sins and rededicate their lives to Christ. Paul developed a method for giving parish mission talks that involved laypeople.

Paul received gifts of prophecy and healing from the Holy Spirit. He was so powerful when he preached and so gentle in confession that he brought many sinners back to the Lord.

Paul once said, "England is always before my eyes, and if ever again it becomes Catholic, the benefit to the Church will be immeasurable." Within 65 years, a Passionist named Dominic Barberi went to England to help reconcile John Henry Newman and others to the Catholic Church, aiding the revival of Catholicism there. Paul of the Cross died in 1775.

Why World Mission Sunday Matters



The World Mission Sunday collection today, October 20th, inspired in the efforts made by laywoman Blessed Pauline Jaricot, who founded the Society for the Propagation of the Faith back in 1822. She asked her friends to pray for the Church in mission territories daily, and donate a penny a week. Two-thirds of those first pennies raised were sent to the vast diocese of Louisiana, which then extended from the Florida Keys to Canada. In the United States, we benefited from the collection held by the Society until 1908. Throughout the years, we received \$7 million, the equivalent of over \$250 million today. The Church in the United States was once mission territory, heavily reliant on support from Catholics worldwide.

Today, U.S. Catholics have the opportunity to return that generosity by supporting global missions.

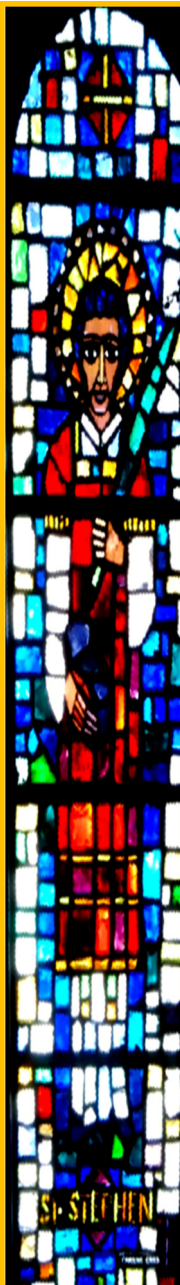
