(8th grade).

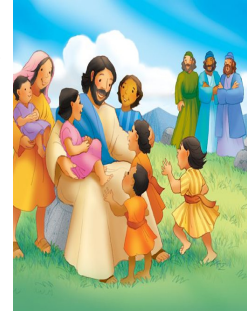
